## Method

Rounds will be scheduled at Multi-club Race Meetings promoted by the ARDC (Eastern Creek), Wakefield Park and NSWRRRC (Oran Park). One race meeting at an interstate circuit may also be included.

Category/Series Management will be provided by PRB Motorsport Australia, and will include formulation of series/vehicle rules and regulations, driver registration, event entry, eligibility, prizes and sponsorship/publicity

## Eligibility

Open to any PRB S2, PRB Composite, PRB/Birkin S3 (to end 2005) vehicles and all future PRB models with either a CAMS 2B or 2A logbook, subject to acceptance by PRB Motorsport

## Proposed classes

1601-2000cc modified  
Up to 1600cc modified  
Up to 2000cc standard

Performance limiting controls will apply to cars with forced induction

## Entry

Registrants will be financially incented to enter for all rounds. Entrants may be a member of any CAMS-affiliated club. Championship registration will be compulsory

## Publicity

The PRB Racing Championship will be covered in a number of the major national motorsport publications. Corporate entertainment will be available at each round. A Championship website will be provided
